



BELIZE'S PARROTS ARE PROTECTED UNDER THE WILDLIFE PROTECTION ACT.

Hunting, buying, selling or keeping any species of parrot is an offence carrying a fine of up to \$1000 and/or 6 months imprisonment.

If you already have a parrot in captivity you must get a permit. ALL captive parrots must have a permit issued by the Belize Forest Department.

Permits are subject to compliance with minimum standards. Contact your local Forest Department Office for more information.

Report all cases of illegally kept wildlife to the Belize Forest Department.
