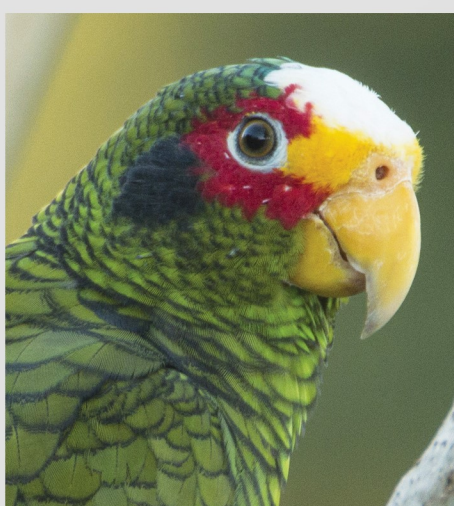

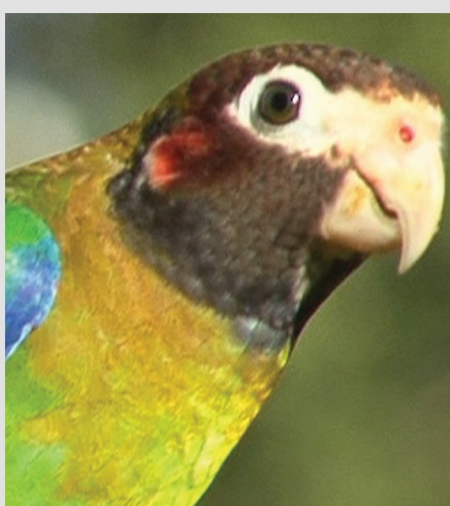

BELIZE'S PARROTS ARE PROTECTED UNDER THE WILDLIFE PROTECTION ACT.

Hunting, buying, selling or **keeping** any species of parrot is an offence carrying a fine of up to \$1000 and/or 6 months imprisonment.

If you **already have a parrot** in captivity you must get a permit.
ALL captive parrots must have a permit issued by the Belize Forest Department.

Permits are subject to compliance with minimum standards.
Contact your local Forest Department Office for more information.

Report all cases of **illegally kept wildlife** to the Belize Forest Department.
