We are very excited to announce an opening for a Belizean National or Resident to join our dynamic NGO dedicated to the rescue, rehabilitation and release of all bird species in Belize. This is a full-time position on a 3-month trial, potentially leading to permanent employment.

The successful candidate will be expected to become an integral part of a small, cohesive and committed team and will be working with all species of native birds, carrying out all aspects of BBR's work including diets and husbandry, hand-feeding techniques, handling, behaviour recognition and rehabilitation tasks.

No experience is necessary as full training will be given.

This position includes working in all-weather conditions. You must be truly passionate about birds and have a love for all animals, no exceptions! Applicants should be receptive to training and want to learn every aspect of avian rehabilitation. This position may lead to permanent employment.

Applicants must be:

- Passionate about wildlife
- Belizean National or Resident
- English and Spanish speaking
- Live in close proximity to, and be able to get themselves to and from the Rescue Centre in Roaring Creek, Cayo District
- Willing to work as part of a small team, as well as independently

Must also have a good standard of written English.

No experience in avian rehabilitation is necessary as full training will be given. Qualifications and/or experience in the field of conservation is a distinct advantage.
